

# **SOUTH MITKOF ISLAND FERRY TERMINAL**



This new ferry terminal is located on the southern tip of Mitkof Island in the south-east panhandle of Alaska. It is remote from any towns, being about 25 miles from the town of Petersburg. The terminal was designed and built to accommodate one ship in a new fleet of "Fast" ferries which now service much of southeast Alaska. The site has no utility power or other services, so required the installation of a 100KW generator in a custom-designed enclosure.

In addition to the generator, Puffin's work consisted of installing all the underground distribution wiring and equipment, plus the lighting and wiring to service a 900 foot-long approach trestle, a pontoon dock and hydraulic, elevator loading ramp and 2 auxiliary buildings.

Puffin Electric was the electrical subcontractor to Western Marine Construction of Seattle, Washington.
